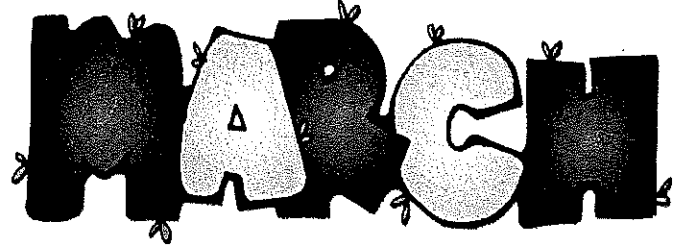

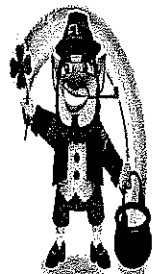

When requesting documents from your file such as a copy of your lease for programs such as food stamps or energy assistance programs, please call and request 24 hours in advance.

There is a charge to copy of .25 cents per page and \$1.00 per page for fax.

**ATTENTION PET OWNERS:**

Please read these important notes regarding the pet policy. If you do not obey the complete pet policy which you signed when you moved in you could be subject to eviction.

- A RESIDENT OF A DWELLING UNIT IN BRICK HOUSING MAY OWN A COMMON HOUSEHOLD PET OR HAVE A COMMON HOUSEHOLD PET PRESENT IN THE DWELLING UNIT OF SUCH RESIDENT, SUBJECT TO THE REASONABLE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BHA, IF THE RESIDENT MAINTAINS SUCH PET WITHOUT ANNOYANCE OR NUISANCE TO THE BHA RESIDENTS AND WITHOUT CREATING ANY PROBLEMS IN COMMON AREAS OR FACILITIES.
- TENANT MUST CERTIFY AND AGREE TO THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MANAGEMENT OF SAID PET AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE PET PERMIT CAN BE REVOKED FOR FAILURE TO FOLLOW PET MANAGEMENT RULES ONE OF WHICH IS: PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO REMAIN STATIONARY IN ANY COMMON AREA, SUCH AS BUILDING ENTRANCES, LOBBIES, HALLWAYS, COMMUNITY ROOM, LAUNDRY ROOM, ETC., WHICH MAY BE USED FOR INGRESS AND EGRESS PURPOSES.
- PET OWNING TENANTS ARE EXPECTED TO APPROPRIATELY TRAIN AND CARE FOR THEIR COMPANION ANIMALS TO ENSURE THAT THEY ARE NOT A NUISANCE OR DANGER TO OTHER TENANTS AND DO NOT DAMAGE BHA PROPERTY.
- PETS MUST GO DIRECTLY FROM THEIR FLOOR TO THE ELEVATOR AND DOWN TO THE FIRST FLOOR TO MAIN ENTRANCE.
- UPON DETERMINATION BY BHA MANAGEMENT, SOME CAUSES FOR REVOCATION OF PET PERMIT ARE: PET CAUSED DAMAGE TO BHA OR TENANT PROPERTY, PET HAS BITTEN OR SCRATCHED ANY PERSON, PET MAKES ANIMAL SOUNDS THAT ARE GENERALLY ANNOYING TO TENANTS AND MANAGEMENT SUCH AS LOUD OR REPEATED BARKING.
- ALL PET OWNING TENANTS HEREBY CERTIFY AND AGREE TO THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MANAGEMENT OF THIS PET BY THE TENANT, AND UNDERSTANDS AND ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE PET PERMIT CAN BE REVOKED FOR FAILURE TO FOLLOW AND ABIDE BY THE PET POLICY.
- NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PET POLICY CAN RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF THE PET OR EVICTION.

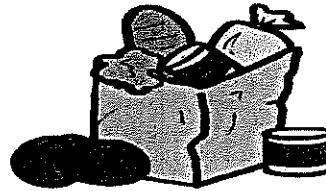

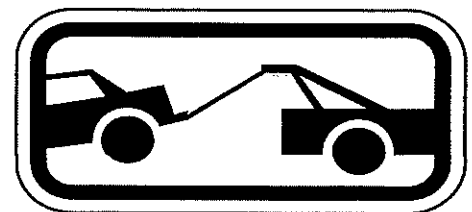
**ATTENTION CAR OWNERS:**

**Do not risk having your car towed at your expense.**





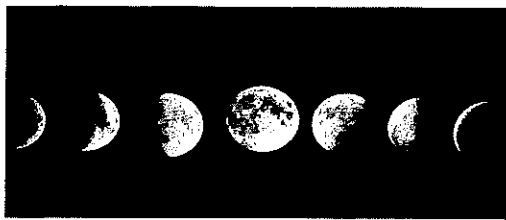

## ANNUAL SPRING/SUMMER REMINDERS

- Household garbage is to be bagged, tied and dropped down the chute or carried out to dumpster. Please do not leave bags on floor in garbage rooms.
- Recyclables must be put in proper containers; all containers are marked in each room.
- NO SHOPPING CARTS are to be left in building or hallways. Bring them to the far end of parking lot near the bulk dumpster.
- ALL DOGS must be kept on leashes at all times.
- You must PICK UP after your dog, Pooper Scooper Law. You can be fined \$250.
- If you spill or drop anything in the common areas of the building such as hallways, elevators or community room, please clean it up.
- It is illegal to dump food or feed the animals outside such as birds and squirrels. This violates State Law and you could be fined.
